Harbor Dept. Engineer of Thirty Years Retires Here

Nearly 35 years of service with the city of Los Angeles, 30 of them spent in the Harbor Dept., will come to a close this week as Samuel C. Sault retires from his post of civil engineering associate with the Harbor Department.

Sault's career began shortly after World War I, when he was appointed deputy civil engineer of the city of Wilmington.

In 1920 this Keystone resident became a junior engineer for the Harbor Dept. He was later elevated to the post of assistant civil engineer. This position was abolished in 1950, and Sault was named civil engineering associate.

70th Birthday
During more than three decades spent in the harbor area, Sault, who had his 70th birthday this week, has seen the Los Angeles and Long Beach harbors changed from a near-duck pond to the second ranking port in the United States.

When he came to the West Coast in 1908, the first harbor breakwater was under construction, and sailing vessels far outnumbered the steamers anchored in the bay.

In his years at the San Pedro office of the Harbor Dept., he saw the channel widened from its original 500 feet to its present 1000 feet, and deepened from 30 to 40 feet.

Currently a captain in the 4th Battalion of the California National Guard Reserve, Sault is very active in Post 287 of the American Legion, which he joined in 1922. He came up through the ranks of the Legion, holding every office of the organization, including 17 years as the post chaplain, a post he still holds. He is now the Chairman of the Hospital Commission of the Harbor District American Legion. His wife is vice-chairman of the Legion Auxiliary, and is active in work at the VA Hospital in Long Beach.

After his retirement, Sault states that he plans to devote most of his time to Legion work, especially the hospital program. The Saults reside at 309 E. 220th St., Keystone.
