# **Lynn Case** Moved to

The case of Bert Lynn vs. dance slated for Oct. 11, it was ported. the City of Torrance will be heard in the South Bay Municipal Court in Redondo Beach and not in Torrance City Court after a change of venue was granted the defendant, it was revealed this week by Don Armstrong, attorney for

Change of venue allows the defendant th right to have the trial heard in another community instead of the one in which the alleged crime was committed.

No date for the trial has been set, Armstrong said. Lynn pleaded not guilty to charges of 16 counts of violation of land use variance and conditional permit at a preliminary hearing held here last month.

Maximum penalty is a fine of 300 for each count, and possibly jail term. The City alleges in its suit that for 16 days Lynn wilfully and deliberately violated the provisions of an original variance granted at

the time of construction of a medical center at 2406 Torrance Blvd. The violation occurred when Lynn began the construction of an addition to the existing facility. Lynn states that he proceeded with the addition only after he had

obtained a permit from the City. The City alleges that the building permit was issued inadvertently. and that Lynn was bound by the provisions of the original variance which prohibited further construction on the lot, unless additional parking facilities were provided.

Five bids, ranging from \$39,025 to \$79,268 were entered for the one million gallon reservoir slated for North Torrance. The low bid of \$39,025 was submitted by the Chicago Bridge and Iron Co. The plan submitted is for a steel tank, rather than concrete, which the engineer's plans call for.

Eight construction firms bid for the job of constructing the ten million gallon tank in South Torrance. These bids ranged from \$422,268 to \$518,761. The award will be made at the

next regular meeting, after they have been studied by the engineering dept.
