

Torrance P-TA Urges 'Yes' Vote On Proposition 2

The recent meeting of the Torrance Council P-TA was presided over by Mrs. Victor Benard, president of Torrance Council, had as its theme "Working Together."

During the business session, Mrs. Robert Moffitt, 3rd vice president announced that CCPTA is supporting two ballot measures to provide for California school children. The P-TA urges a "Yes" vote on the State School Building Aid Measure, which will make \$185,000,000 available for loans to needy school districts to build classrooms, and on proposition 2, the initiative measure which will provide more money for the operation of schools.
