

\$3,000 Needed by Dental Health Group

An estimated \$3,000 will be needed for the coming year for the program being followed by the Torrance Dental Health Association, Inc. it was reported at the first quarterly meeting of that group last Friday.

The non-profit organization is designed to render dental service to children attending schools in the Torrance Unified School District.

After a study, the association was found to establish a fund whereby children who are found to require dental attention, yet whose parents are unable to pay for the services, would not be neglected.

The Parent Teachers Association of Torrance proposed the plan and made initial contributions of money to start the program. The plan attracted the attention of several other organizations in Torrance and the fund has been increased to its present point of \$1,400.

There are four local dentists participating in the plan to provide Torrance children with dental aid when they need it.

Officers of the association are: Dean L. Sears, president; Paul Diamond, vice president; Mrs. H. E. Carr, secretary; Mrs. A. C. Turner, treasurer; Mrs. Ralph Bee, executive secretary and

chairman of the dental committee; Walter Rehewdt, school representative; and George Powell, chairman of finance committee. Participating dentists are Drs. J. S. Roberts, William Bryant, Robert Musulas, and Arthur Berke.
