Dunn, Keller Retire from GP Refinery

Two Torrance refinery employees of the General Petroleum Corporation were retired Saturday, Nov. 1.
Harry Dunn, 8216 1/2 S. Denker, and John F. Keller, 11203 La Salle Ave., Los Angeles, have both been employed in General Petroleum's Engineering Construction department, and by a quirk of fate have

almost identical company careers and background.
Both men share the same birthdate, though Dunn born in Iowa and Keller in Pennsylvania. They both were first employed by General Petroleum on April 18, 1933 as boilermakers at Torrance.
Shortly afterward Dunn and Keller were headquartered in company offices at Vernon, returning to Torrance in 1947.
Dunn retires as General Shop Foreman and Keller as Tank Work Supervisor. They retire under General Petroleum's Annuity Plan which dates back to 1912.
