The home was gaily decorated for the Christmas season, and of particular interest was the beautiful winter scene painted on the front window.

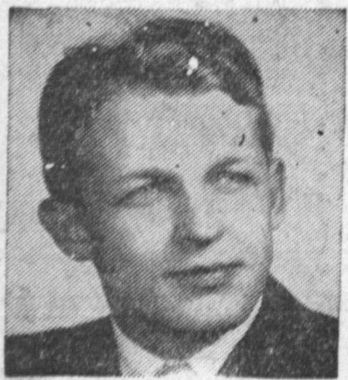
