Local Housing Standard Rates High in State Study

The people of Torrance live better than most families in California. Their homes are better heated, equipped with superior plumbing facilities and refrigeration, and are less crowded than the average dwelling in the state.

These facts are reported by the Gas Appliance Manufacturers Association which recently analyzed latest census reports on national housing characteristics and determined that 51.8 per cent of Torrance's homes are equipped with central heating as compared with 44.1 per cent for all of California.

The GAMA analysis shows that 90.5 per cent of Torrance's homes have hot running water and private bath as contrasted with 86 per cent for the entire state and that 87.9 per cent are equipped with mechanical refrigeration. Natural gas predominates as the city's heating, water heating and cooking fuel.
