Telephone Tips

In preparation for the changeover to dial operation here at 12:01 a.m. Sunday, Torrance Telephone Manager R. S. Pyle gave the following tips on dial usage for FAirfax subscribers:

1. Know the correct number to be dialed by consulting the new telephone directory supplement.

2. Wait for the dial tone before calling.

3. Dial each letter and number correctly, distinguishing between the numeral "0" and the letter "0," and between the numeral "1" and the letter "I."

4. Let the dial return at its own speed.

5. Dial "113" for information.

6. Dial "114" for telephone repair service.

7. Dial "116" or the operator for the fire department, police, ambulance service, or the sheriff.


