DEBATE BOND ISSUE

Because of the rapid school growth demanded by a rapidly growing city, the Board of Education discussed the need for raising three million dollars either by a one dollar over-ride tax or bond issue.

While present funds have been sufficient to cope with present needs, the number of schools which will be built per year has changed from two to four, the Board was told, requiring additional funds.

A similar bond issue was raised two years ago.

At present, the Board is awaiting the opinion of the Industrial Tax Committee.

It was suggested that the matter be decided at the next election.

Agreement Sets New Wage Rates

Retail Clerks Local 905 food clerks on Nov. 2 ratified the 1953-54 Food Contract, effective Nov. 1, 1953, calling for a wage increase of 5 1/2 cents per hour, or \$2.10 per week, making the 40-hour journeyman rate \$80. The Union had asked for \$10.00 per week, for two additional holidays and many other changes. The new contract calls for hiring part-time apprentices and students; change in the method of computing vacation pay; requirement of proof of illness for sick pay; revision and redefinition of classifications and duties of assistant managers, head clerks and second men. The new wage rate follows the pattern in adjacent areas set for Locals 324 and 1442. Copies of the new contract are being prepared for signature, according to Frank S. Selover, executive secretary of the Harbor Area Employers' Council.

Retail Bakery

Negotiations between Council and Retail Clerks Local 905 have resulted in a settlement of the retail bakery contract, effective Nov. 1, 1953, calling for an increase of \$1 per week, to \$33 for journeymen, 40 hours. Other minor improvements were made. The Union had asked for an increase of \$4 per week.

TV, Radio

The agreement with International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local 11-2, covering television, radio and electronics technicians, has been settled for an increase of .06875 cents per hour, or \$2.75 per week, making the journeyman rate \$90 for 40 hours. Improvements negotiated require technicians to acquaint themselves with new developments and changes in electronics and television to increase their efficiency on the job. The agreement is effective Nov. 1, 1953.
