Created by the government to families have moved into the area as the result of defense production, the two laws provide for federal assistance in building new schools and in the operation of the schools.

Public Law 815 provides for funds to expand plants and for the construction of new schools, while Public Law 874 provides funds to help the district pay for the costs of maintenance and operation.

School Superintendent J. H. Hull said that more than \$60,000 in federal funds may be obtained by the district from the latter law.

The district has already received \$964,000 under the provision of Public Law 815 for new construction and has received entitlement for additional funds. However, no additional funds have been appropriated by Con-


