

## Bond Issue Creates More Classrooms

Six new schools, representing 24 classrooms, will be made available through the \$3,000,000 school bond issue to be voted on March 9, it was announced. The bond issue has received the endorsement of the Chamber of Commerce, the Torrance Industries Tax Committee, and the Torrance Educational Advisory Committee.

The bond issue will cost about 12 cents per hundred dollars of assessed valuation.

While some double sessions will not be eliminated, the bond issue will go a long way in remedying that situation. The program would be about 24 classes short of the necessary

classrooms, it was reported. With the opening of the Carr School this week, the Wood School in February, and the Meadow Park School about March, the number of elementary rooms available will rise to 194.

## CHURCH TO BUILD NEW SCHOOL UNIT

Contract for building of the educational unit and patio and remodeling of the basement of the present building of the First Methodist Church of Torrance was awarded Thursday, January 14, to the Hann Construction company of Compton, it was announced by Robert Reid, chairman of the building committee.

The three-story structure is designed for the church school and includes a recreation room, kitchenette, and classrooms. The third floor of the building overhangs the patio. The administrative unit and some church school departments are now located in the former parsonage.

Construction, which begins this month, it to be completed in five months. Arrangements have been made with the contractor to subcontract some of the work to the men of the church. Total cost of construction will be \$52,568.

Gerrard-Inslee of Los Angeles were the architects. Earl Miller is president and Leo Radford, secretary of the Board of Trustees.
