King Asks For Aid to Shipyards

Strong federal action to protect local shipyards and shipyard workers from "serious economic dislocation" has been demanded in a resolution submitted to Congress by Rep. Cecil R. King of the 17th District. It was announced today.

"Continued inaction will endanger national defense and the economic well-being of the shipping industry," the Congressman warned.

King's resolution (H.R. 513) stressed that private ship and construction repair yards in California are declining in activity "so rapidly that the degree of future activity remains doubtful." He stated further that national defense is impaired by this reduced activity since well dispersed yards are necessary to form a mobilization base in an emergency.
