The boy or girl have heard that their father is no good and that they should not see him. Where are they to turn? This in itself is enough to cause delinquency.

So the thing that we must do is this. Attempt to correct any of the aforementioned if they exist in our homes. Give the boys and girls new and changing experience. Trade them something better than what they have now. More understanding, more love, and security. Give them something to do. Give them recreation. This will help solve the problem of juvenile delinquency in our community.
