The bride's sister, Rose Marie Morris, was maid of honor, and wore a gown of aqua net over taffeta, as she carried a bouquet of pink.

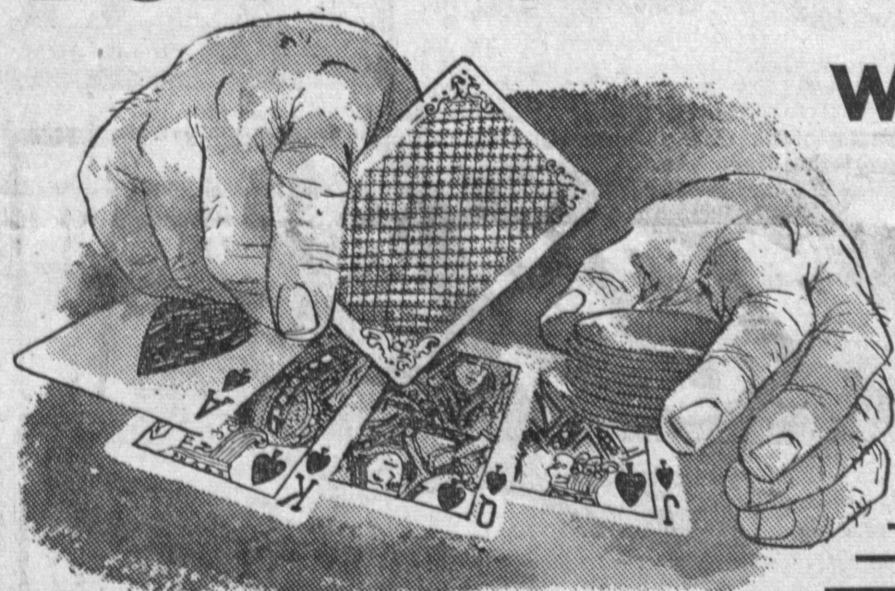

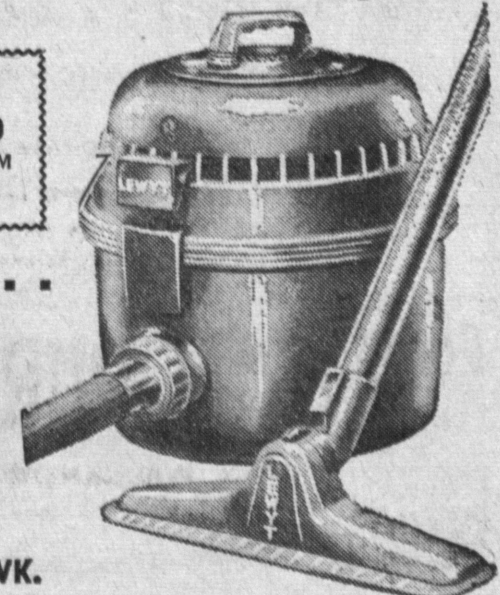
