

SUMMER RECREATION PROGRAM ANNOUNCED

The Torrance recreation department this week released its booklet of the Torrance summer recreation program to the children at all Torrance schools. The program, which is scheduled to begin June 21, will be conducted at four parks and eight school grounds. The parks will be open from 10 a.m. to 10 p.m. daily Monday through Friday from June 21 until September 3.

The school areas will be open 1 p.m. to 6 p.m. daily Monday through Friday from June 21 until July 30.

From August 1 until August 27, the school playgrounds will remain open from 10 a.m. until 6 p.m. Monday through Friday.

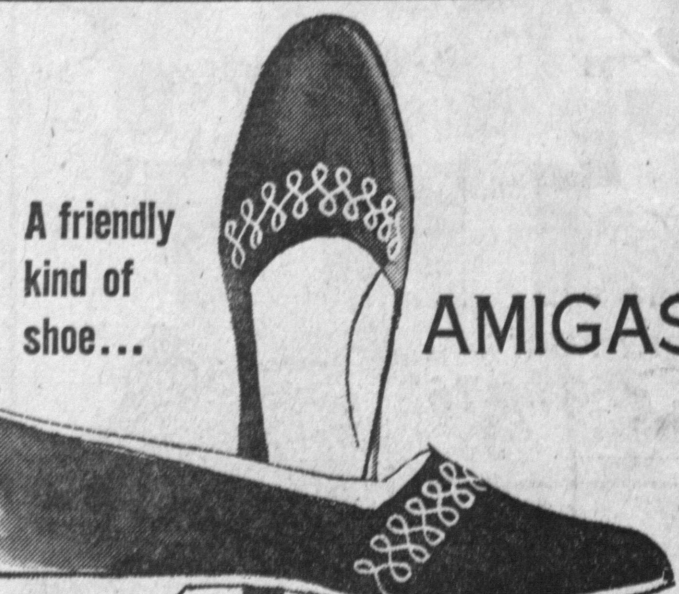

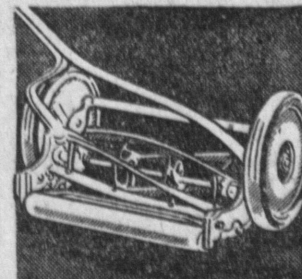

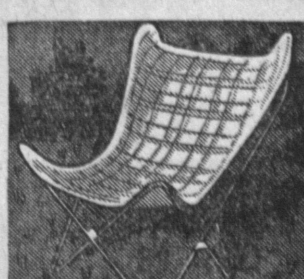
