

## WEST BASIN URGED TO REDUCE PUMPING

Copies of an interim agreement and petition to reduce pumping by an estimated 37% from the depleted West Basin ground water reservoir have been mailed to 472 water producing agencies.

All West Basin cities, private water companies, major industries and a long list of individual water well owners will receive copies of the document. The agreement will become effective when signed by parties representing 70 per cent of the annual water production from the Basin.

## ASTHMA PATENTS and their problems

Inhaling and exhaling of the necessary air for the body's use are accomplished mainly by the action of the diaphragm, which is a muscle separating the lungs from the stomach and intestines. When the diaphragm is contracted air is drawn into the lungs; when it relaxes, the patient exhales the air and poisonous gases. If stomach or intestine gases are forced up the diaphragm upward, the patient will have difficulty in forcing the pressure down sufficiently to inhale. A

weak diaphragm will be unable to do its work properly under this condition, and there will be a struggle to draw enough air into the lungs resulting in the peculiar wheeze of the asthmatic when attempting to inhale. ## Park-Fee Issue Has Far-Reaching Effect

No action has been taken so far by Henry Griswold, owner of the Ambassador Construction Co., who declared that he would sue the city and city councilmen over the legality of a \$100 park and recreation fee per gross acre.

Griswold demanded that the city refund \$3878.52 which he paid under protest. The city refused to do so and said it would take the case to the California

supreme court to test the law's legality, if necessary. The city stands to lose \$30,000 already collected from vari-

ous contractors under the one-year-old ordinance.

Legality of the parks and recreation fee ordinance is definitely a controversial question. This is a precedent-setting situation and an opinion rendered by the supreme court of California would affect policies in every city of the state, according to City Attorney James Hall.

The argument in favor of the ordinance is that a city government has the inherent power to protect its citizens and preserve the general welfare, as well as raise funds for that service. It is argued that it is the duty of those who profit most to contribute to the cost of that service.

The legality of the ordinance is questioned, however, on the grounds that the government is taking away property or funds from individuals without compensation (eminent domain).
