JUVENILE PROTECTION DISCUSSED

Juvenile protection chairman of the P-TA deal with the moral safety of the children, not the physical safety, according to Mrs. W. H. Farwell, 259th Place School P-TA chairman.

It is important for the chairman to watch for places where minors may buy cigarettes or liquor, to watch for stores selling obscene literature, to watch for amusement places that are not kept clean or conducted properly, to watch for rival gangs and vandalism, and to report these to the local community groups for help in the correction of these offenses, Mrs. Farwell said.

In attending the juvenile protection meetings, Mrs. Farwell learned of several laws governing children which many parents do not know. For instance, parents are liable if minors under 18 years of age are found loitering on the streets after 10 p.m.

Also minors under 16 years must be accompanied by an adult at any dance or skating rink after 6 p.m.

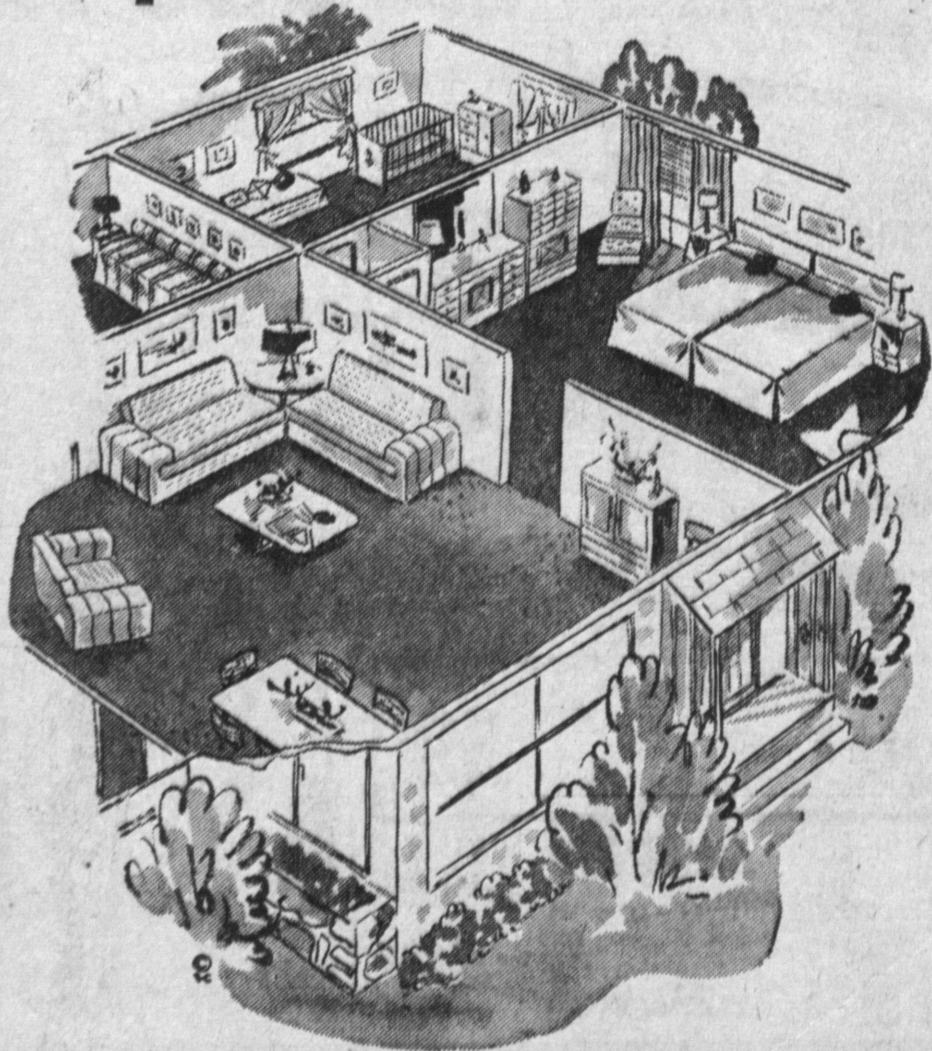
