James Smith, driver for the stakes prize in the Second Annual All-Southern California of Torrance, won the sweep School Bus Rodeo.



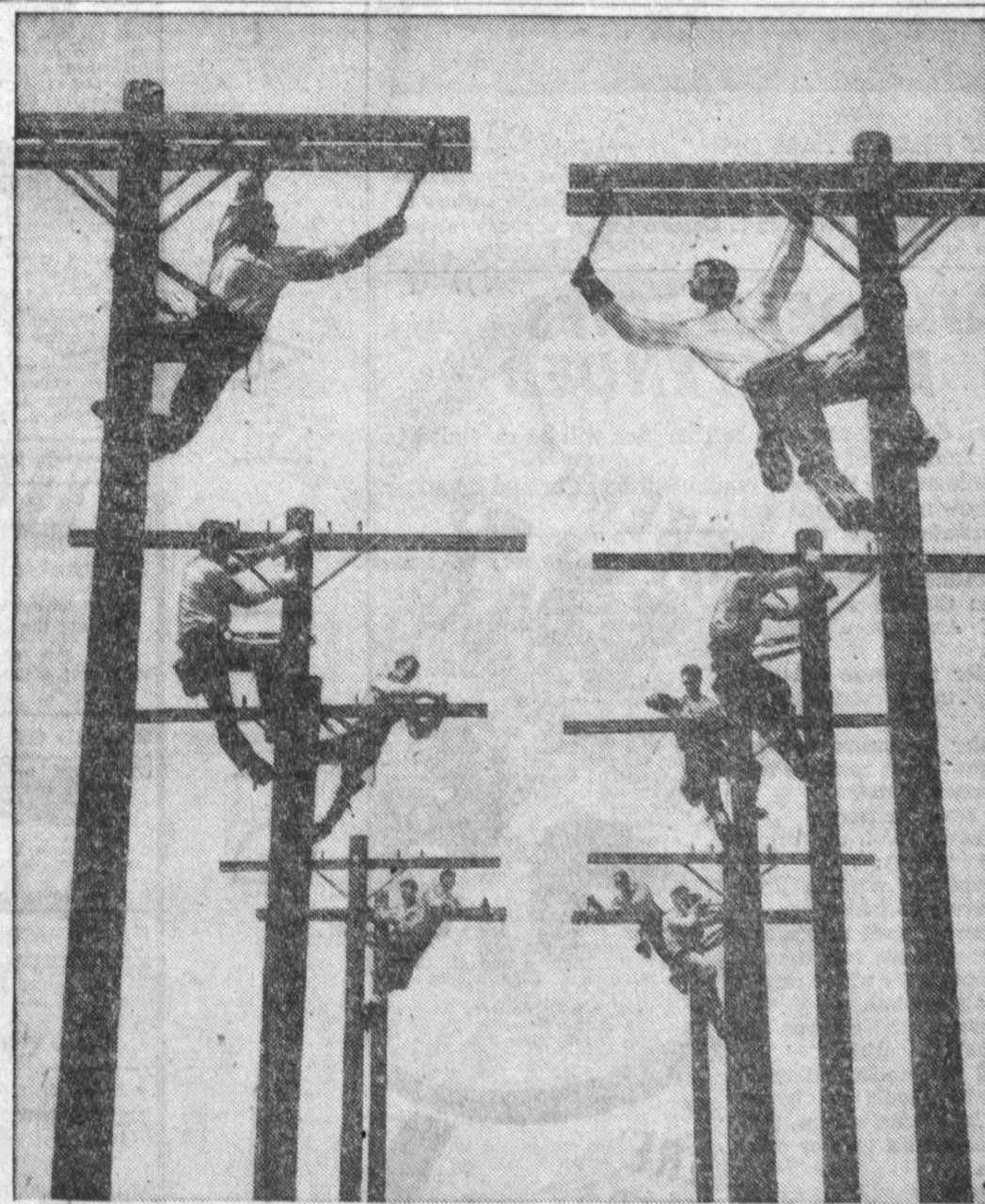
