Blimp Tours Scheduled At Airport

The craft, operated by the Goodyear Aircraft Corp., plans to make flights from the field each Sunday after a series of test hops here this week.

R. H. Hobensack, in charge of the service for Goodyear, said the blimp will be at the field from about 10 a.m. until 5 p.m. each Sunday. It is based at Rosemead Airport during the

It will land and take off from the extreme west end of the main taxi-way, where it will not interfere with airplane traffic, according to Dietrich.

The non-rigid craft has an envelope which contains 123,000 cubic feet of helium, a noninflammable gas. The envelope is made of two-play rubberized nylon, which Hobensack said is lighter and stronger than the three-play rubberized cotton formerly used. It is propelled by two 145-horsepower engines attached to the gondola which carries six passengers and a pilot. The Enterprise is an L-type blimp, smallest of seven types built by Goodyear and used by the Navy for Anti-submarine patrols during World War II.


