

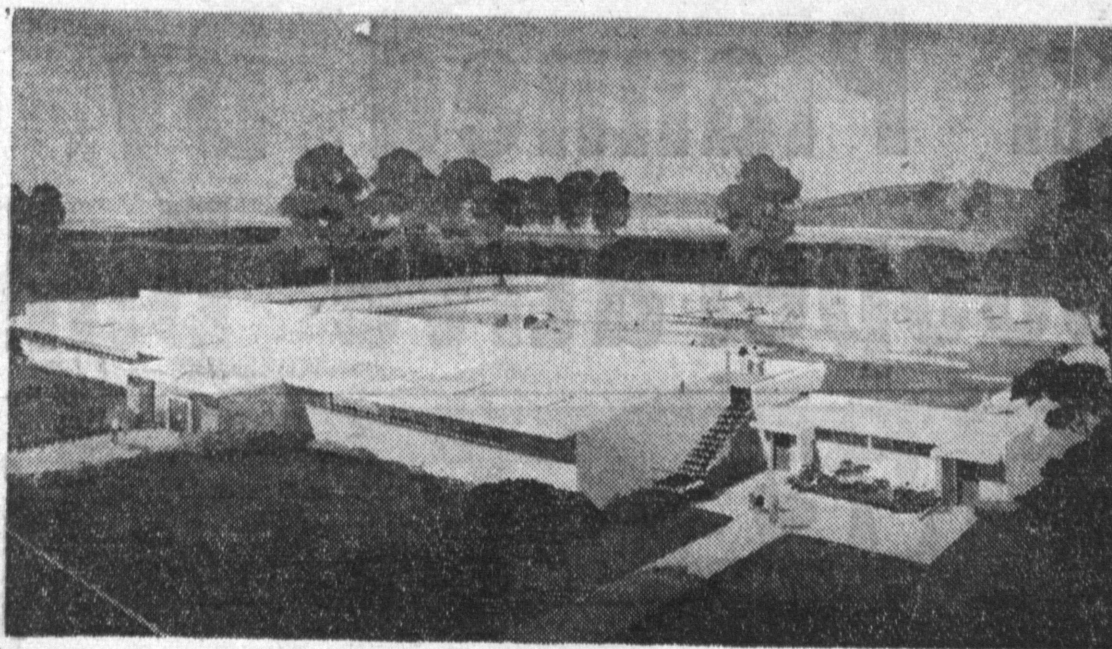
Residents Win Three Prizes

BONDING BEST METHOD TO PAY FOR SWIMMING POOL

With the Swimming Pool Bond issue facing the voters within a few short weeks, it should be pointed out to those Torrance citizens who object to bonding themselves for a swimming pool that unless the City does bond itself there may never be a City-owned Swimming Pool in Torrance.

Advantages

The advantage to the bond method of paying for a Swimming Pool is that it allows the taxpayers to pay for the pool over a long period of time while they are enjoying the pool.

The purpose of the swimming pool is to meet the need for more healthful recreation in the City. If we wait to pay cash for it, we may never get the pool.

With the rising costs of such construction, it may cost more to pay cash for such a pool ten or fifteen years from now than it would cost to build the pool now and pay the interest and principal on the bonds while we enjoy the pool.

The Swimming Pool planned to be constructed with the bond

issue money is designed to meet the needs of the City of Torrance for many years to come. It won't be a case of building too little too late.

Indoor Pool Later

It is even planned to so construct the pool that it may be housed in a building at a later date if the citizens would desire to do so. Much thought and hard work has gone into the pool plans over a long period of years. Different groups have sponsored the swimming pool project in the past. And this year, the Torrance City Council and the Torrance Recreation Commission put many days of study into the plans.
