The nine-member board was established by the hospital's founder, the late J. S. Torrance, who specified it should consist of two licensed physicians, and three women and four men who are not physicians.

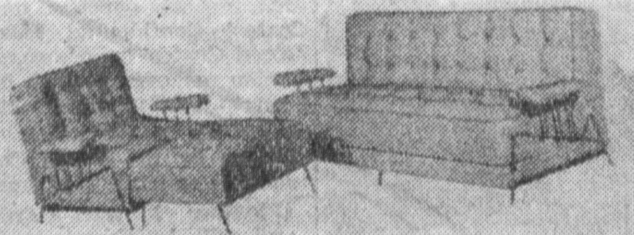
#### Present Board
