Four Bids Received For Harbor Pool

The Los Angeles City Recreation and Park Commission received and referred for analysis and report to George Hjelte, general manager of the Recreation and Park Department, four bids for the construction of Harbor Park Municipal swimming pool.

The four bidders and the amount of their tenders were: Oppert and Forsberg, \$161,000; M. J. Brock and Son, Inc., \$162,400; John L. Volz Company, \$169,870; Carter Mack Builders, \$179,525.

According to the Recreation and Park Department, the 60-foot-wide, 120-foot-long Harbor Park pool will be constructed on city-owned property at the intersection of North Figueroa and "L" streets. Its depth will range from 3½ feet at the ends to a maximum of 9 feet in the center, the department said.

The pool's water will be heated, and its decks will be warmed by radiant heating, the department added.

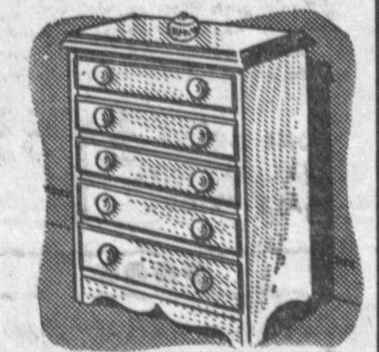

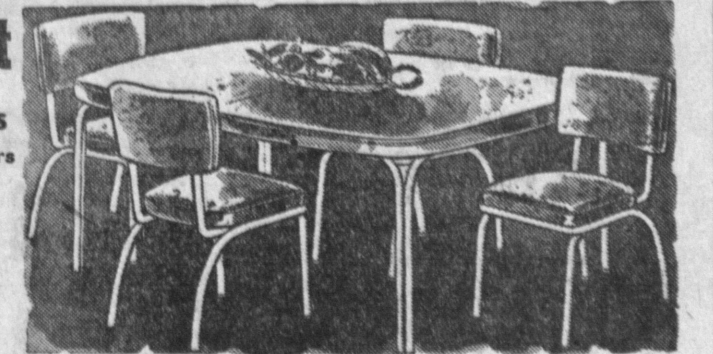
