# Torrance Mounties Hunt 3 'Injured,' 'Missing' Juveniles in Rolling Hills

## HUNT CALLED TO TEST GROUP'S EFFICIENCY

Nineteen members of the Torrance Mounted Police responded with lightning-speed efficiency Saturday to comb the Rolling Hills area near the police pistol range for three "missing" juveniles assumed seriously injured.

This unannounced test-hunt was called to see how quickly and efficiently the Torrance Mounted Police could act in cases of emergency. Saturday's results were regarded with a great deal of satisfaction by all concerned.

After the emergency call was issued at 9 a.m., the first patrol arrived and was assembled within one hour. All three patrols were ready for action within one hour and 45 minutes after the call.

The first patrol had to locate one missing juvenile in the rugged 10-square mile terrain.

Upon locating the boy who had "fallen" into a canyon the mounties had to "treat" him for simple fracture of the right lower leg; 2 inch cut on right calf not bleeding severely; fractured left rib and shock.

The victim was located and treated within 40 minutes.

The second and third problems were combined and both the second and third patrols were sent to handle them.

**Other Victims**  
One involved a child fallen from a tree who "suffered" a fractured left collar bone, a severe sprain of the left ankle, abrasions of left knee, and possible spine fracture.

Also involved was a child who had "run" into fallen hot electric wire. At the time detected, the child was supposedly bluish in color, not breathing, with a 2 inch cut on the calf of the right
