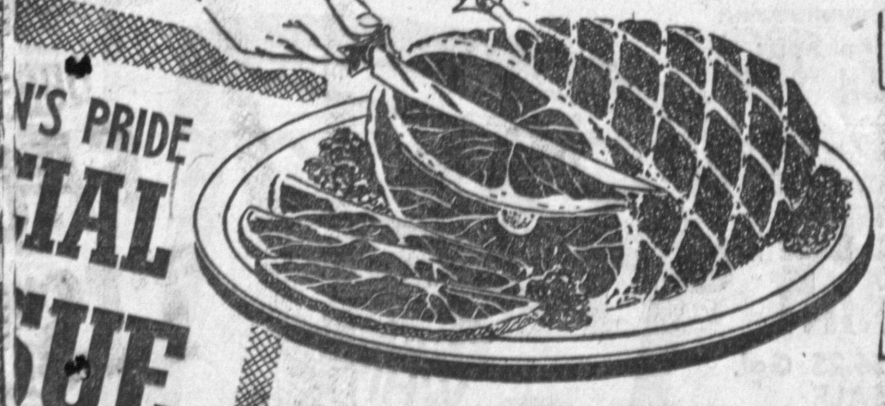

Torrance area. Thomas mustered 11,165 votes to Willd's 3252. At press time, the total for 248 out of 262 precincts for the whole district gave Thomas 30,998 votes and Willd 10,375 votes.

The Torrance area vote for some other important offices and propositions tallied as follows:

Close Margin

Governor Goodwin Knight (R) with a total of 10,912 votes by a slight margin over his Democratic opponent, Richard Graves with 9,855 votes in the gubernatorial contest.

For the post of lieutenant governor Edward R. Roybal, with a total of 10,468 votes, had the edge on incumbent Harold J. Powers (R), who totaled 10,040 votes. State-wide, Powers won the election over Roybal.

While Senator Thomas Kuchel defeated his Democratic opponent, Samuel Yorty, in the overall state election, Torrance voters gave Yorty a slight edge over Kuchel, with 10,594 votes going to Yorty and 9055 to Kuchel.

Ousted

Ousted from his seat on the Board of Equalization state-wide as well as in the Torrance vote was William G. Bonelli (D). Bonelli received 9097 votes here as opposed to 10,929 for his challenger, Robert McDavid (R).

Residential kick-offs staged today by other Harbor Area towns participating in the Los Angeles area Community Chest appeal include Lomita, Wilmington, Harbor City, San Pedro, Gardena, Palos Verdes and Rolling Hills, whose individual quotas will render a Harbor Area Residential quota of \$52,161. Another \$31,018 pledged by Commerce and Industry Divisions brings the Harbor Area total goal to \$83,179 which will go into the overall Los Angeles goal of \$8,652,000.

was halted at the former location, Anaheim street and Normandie avenue, and clearing of the site was under way.

The 19-acre Bixby Slough site is under condemnation by the city for inclusion in development of the area into a huge aquatic park.

Agajanian and Schubert sought to move the dump to an abandoned brick pit at Normandie and Vermont avenues, but they were denied a variance by the Los Angeles City Planning Commission.

The new location was acquired by the pair when they bought out the Pfan Co., a holding corporation. The new locale

Next on the Planning Commission agenda is the rezoning of Crenshaw boulevard.

The City Council has asked that this matter be given priority. One difficulty encountered at present in discussing the rezoning of Crenshaw is that the street is still to be expanded. A committee is to be appointed to study the Crenshaw boulevard problem, according to Powell.
