

RECOMMENDED TOPICS FOR TEAC DISCUSSION

A number of subjects, 21 in all, were suggested to the Board of Education as possible topics for the Torrance Educational Advisory Committee by Dr. J. H. Hull, superintendent of schools.

Topics recommended include: penmanship drill, arithmetic and spelling; can't we have standards of achievement in every grade, reading clinic for poor readers in the schools, is our reading program adequate, interpretation of language arts, student demonstrations, what can parents do at home, program showing music program in Torrance schools, math program in elementary schools.

Other suggestions include: graduate survey report on Torrance high school, half-day sessions, bond issue—would it effect us in the near future, school future on the ocean—10 of 65 cases, did the 2 1/2 percent raise affect employment of teachers, high school plans for immediate future 10 to 15 years from now, church school program, safety, school library, responsibility of Board of Education and tie-in with traffic safety and planning commission, how we go about finding talented students and encouraging them.

Major Webber Training On B-47 Stratojet

Major Louis A. Webber, son of Mrs. R. T. Pannet, 1920 Torrance boulevard, Torrance, is undergoing B-47 transition phase training at McConnell Air Force Base, Kansas.

He will return now to his regularly assigned wing of the Strategic Air Command where he will undergo further B-47 Stratojet training. The Boeing-built B-47 Stratojet is a six engine medium bomber and flies in the 600 mph class.

The B-47 transition phase training covers approximately two and a half months of intensive academic and flying training which includes 150 hours of classroom work, 73 hours with instrument trainers and 40 flying hours in the B-47.
