Kids' Xmas Party Set

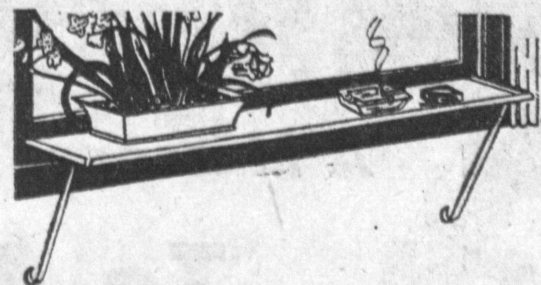
Santa Claus will pay a visit to the youngsters, including animal acts, starring an elephant, a pony, and a dog. The event will be staged on the ball diamond.

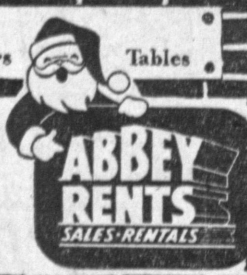


Masonite TABLE TOP

Community Chest Drive Nets 94% Of Goal As End Nears

As local Community Chest fund raising efforts netted a total of \$17,279, campaign leaders were striving to scrape up another \$1000 this week in the interest of turning in all of Torrance's \$18,282 goal at a final report meeting to be held tomorrow noon at the Hotel Ambassador, Los Angeles.

Tomorrow's "clean-up" gathering was called by Chairman Jack Fishburn last week after he announced that 93 per cent of the over-all Los Angeles area goal of \$8,652,000 was in hand, with most area campaigns well past the 90 per cent quota mark and nearing the finishing line.

Local Figures
In Torrance, the Commerce and Industry division made its strongest bid for the lead to date by reporting a 93 per cent quota, to compare with a 95 per cent quota submitted by the residential division. Latest figures on Torrance's Red Feather appeal follow:
Residential: \$10,810, 95 per cent of \$11,373 quota.
Commerce and Industry: \$6,468, 93 per cent of \$6,907 quota.
Total: \$17,279, 94 per cent of \$18,282 goal.

Area Gains
Gains were noted in each of the Harbor area community appeals while Palos Verdes with a 96 per cent quota appeared to be the next group to join the area's "over the top" communities. Latest reports are as follows: Rolling Hills, 142 per cent; Harbor City and Lomita, 133 per cent; Gardena, 73 per cent; Wilmington, 75 per cent; and San Pedro, 71 per cent.

Total money from the above-listed communities tallied as follows for the Harbor area as a whole:
Residential: \$47,597; 92 per cent of \$52,161 quota.
Commerce and Industry: \$23,363, 72 per cent of \$32,529 quota.
Total: \$70,950; 84 per cent of \$85,000 goal.

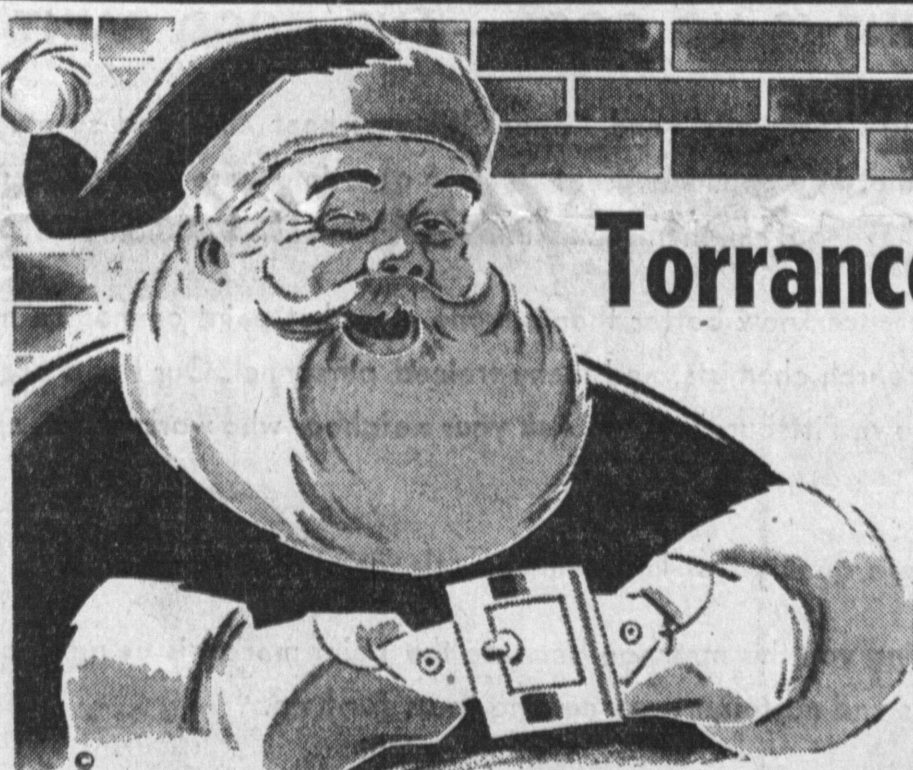
