

Holiday Recreation Schedule For Parks, Playgrounds Told

The Torrance Recreation Department today announced the schedule of recreational activities for the Christmas holidays. Three park areas and six school playgrounds will be opened featuring a broad range of activities. The areas that will remain open Monday through Friday during both holiday weeks include the following:

El Retiro park, 10 a.m. to 5 p.m.; McMaster park, 10 a.m. to 9 p.m.; Waleria park, 10 a.m. to 9 p.m.; Evelyn Carr school, 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.; Madrona Avenue school, 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.; Perry school, 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.; Seaside school, 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.; Waleria school, 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.

other boys. The regular evening school program will continue through the vacation period with boys' basketball and badminton for adults on Monday nights; adult basketball on Tuesday nights; and adult volleyball on Thursday nights.

All park and school playgrounds will feature a program of sports and games for children of all ages. In the event of rainy weather, however, the playgrounds will remain closed and parents are asked not to

send their children to the playground that day.

If other areas desire such a program an attempt will be made to include it in the local program.
