Leases are presently signed or are being negotiated with J. C. Penney, Ralph's market, Thrifty drug stores, Union Oil company and Bolero Bowling Lanes.

Over 50 specialty shops and smaller retail stores will be located in the main shopping center, including a variety store, dry cleaner, specialty food shop, haberdasher, ladies' ready-to-wear, both men and women's shoe stores, jewelry store and a bank.

Lease applications for all retail units are now being accepted by Walter N. Marks, 3460 Wilshire blvd., whose office negotiated all the leases and will continue to be the exclusive leasing agent for the project.

Marks represented both seller and buyer in the sale of the site.

Recreation Center
Adjoining the main shopping area will be a complete recreation center consisting of a restaurant, coffee shop, cocktail lounge and over 50 bowling lanes with automatic pin-setting equipment.

The recreation center will also feature a large community auditorium which will be available for use by women's groups and civic organizations for luncheons, meetings and community functions.

Adding to the convenience of this well-balanced center, will be the location of a medical and professional building just west of the recreational section.

Parking
One of the outstanding features of the South Bay Shopping Center will be a beautifully landscaped parking area on all sides of the building with a

capacity of over 3000 cars at one time.

There will be space allowed at a ratio of seven car spaces to each 1000 square foot of rental area.

In addition to this vast parking area, there will be a covered bus terminal adjacent to the buildings for the convenience of shoppers. Frequent bus service will be maintained throughout the shopping day.

"This announcement signals the go-ahead on a plan which has been in preparation since our acquisition of the land in April of last year," stated Brody.

It is expected that patronage will be obtained from areas reaching as far as Palos Verdes on the south, Inglewood on the north and Compton on the east. The two architectural firms of A. Quincy Jones, Frederick Emmons and Victor Gruen and Associates have collaborated in the design and planning of the center.

A Torrance family has been made happier this week by the release of three-year-old Margaret Brown from the Sister Kenny Polio Hospital in El Monte.

Margaret is the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Richard Brown, Jr., 823 Faysmith avenue, and had been a respirator case when she entered the hospital last November. Richard Brown, Jr., the patient's father is employed by the Los Angeles City Board of Education.

Since the Sister Kenny Polio Hospital opened in 1950, 749 polio victims have undergone Kenny treatment, according to Mrs. Royal C. Penner, 1216 Teri avenue and Mrs. Edward Osborne, 1208 Maple avenue, both of

whom are Sister Kenny Community Relations Council members in Torrance.

Mrs. Penner and Mrs. Osborne also pointed out that the 116-bed Sister Kenny Polio Hospital and its two out-patient clinics are supported by public contributions.

The out-patient clinics which are available free of charge to any polio patient upon request are located on the hospital grounds and in metropolitan Los Angeles at 3808 Ingraham Street.

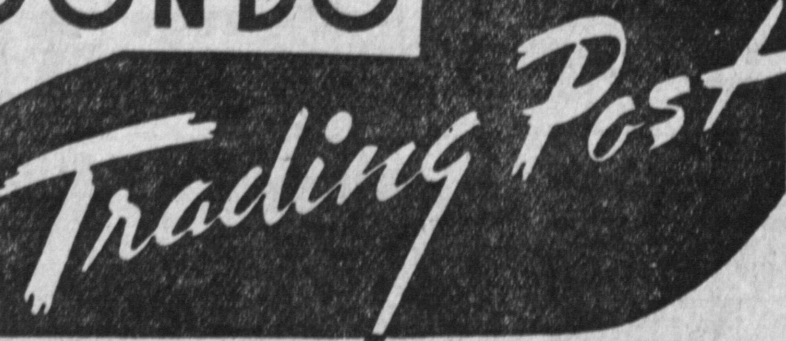
