His loyalty to the Southern cause is evidenced by the fact that he would not sign the oath which could have freed him. "Sister, I am glad I am a rebel, you do not know how

disgraceful your party has acted . . ." he wrote. Negroes Considered Property His letter clearly indicates that he, like other Southerners, thought of the Negro not as a

human being but as property. Your party says they ar fighting for the constitution of their country - this is not so. The Negro is the property of the South by the constitution of the nited States of America and they are instead of protecting them and their right they are stealing them and other

property" On the heartbreaking problem of considering his brothers as enemies, he wrote:

"Give all of my brothers and sisters my best love and tell them that I love them as brothers and sisters — it is the principle that I hate"
