AIR RAID SIGHALS **EXPLAINED**

"Up-to-date information on air raid siren signals was received today by Captain Karney from Howard Earl, County Civil Defense Director," Deputy William Kennard, Mutual Aid District Civil Defense coordinator, said.

Captain Karney, who heads the Lennox Sheriff Station for Sheriff E. W. Biscailuz, is commander of the Lennox Mutual Aid Station.

"At present only one signalthe "take cover" (red alert) signal-will be used in Los Angeles County. This is a 3-minute wailing signal," he emphasized.

"When a dispersal plan is ready and more warning time can be expected, the new FCDA "alert" signal-meaning to disperse or evacuate - will be adopted by the County," he added.

The Federal Civil Defense Administration, on March 4, 1955, adopted these two new civil defense action signals to be sounded by public warning devices and abolished the former "all clear" signal. The State has discontinued further siren tests until a new test signal is developed.

"It will always be wise to turn on your radio when the sirens sound," Deputy Kennard concluded.
