Iverson Sr. Taken By Heart Attack

Sr., 51, automobile dealer and Heart association if they resident of San Pedro for 31 wished. years, died Sunday night of a heart attack at his home, 4500 Maine rd.

Iverson was preparing to have dinner when he was stricken a year ago last January, suffering a heart attack causing him to be hospitalized several weeks.

He leaves his wife, Olive; three sons, William A. jr., Richard B., and Donald S; two grandsons, William A. III and Daniel; two sisters, Mrs. Irene, Sampson and Mrs. Thelma Dearborne.
