

48-Hour Survival

The most rugged portion of the training is the 48-hour survival. After 2 days of training the JLT are divided into groups of 4. Wearing regular clothes with no jackets or ponchos, each carries a knife, and one an axe. The only provisions are 1 cup of sugar and 1/2 cup of salt solely for flavoring.

No fish hooks, matches, or string is carried as they proceed to remote areas where they must survive for two days and nights. The first job is to build a shelter and a fire. And then, of course, the hunt is on for


