Water Here Cut Sharply

In order to keep underground water from reaching dangerously low levels, pumping of water in this area is being voluntarily reduced by 18,000-acre feet during the current fiscal year, according to the West Basin Water association.

Carl Fossette, association secretary, said pumping by 45 agencies, municipal and private, in the west basin is expected to total 54,200 acre-feet during the current period.

In 1953-54, pumping by the agencies totaled 72,900 acre-feet and the previous year it was 78,150 acre-feet.

The agreement to cut back water pumping to what it was in 1949 was reached early this year as a conservation measure.

Additional water, brought from the Colorado river by the Metropolitan Water District will make up for the reduced use of underground water here.


