

At that time, Stoner came out of the house carrying a shotgun. The gun discharged and struck Hart in the thigh. According to Stoner, he shot in self-defense upon being struck on the head by some object. Hart and friends maintained that they were nowhere near Stoner and that they did not hit him with anything.
