Harbor JC Has Record Enrollment

Student enrollment for the spring semester at Harbor junior college has topped all previous records since the opening of the college in September, 1949, Raymond J. Casey, college director stated today.

According to officials records, 1.038 students have registered in day classes and 1,640 in evening classes bringing the total to 2,678 students on campus. This total surpasses last spring's semester totals by 54 day students and 282 evening

When Harbor junior college its doors in September, 1949, 523 day students signed into classes and only 60 extendedday students registered. The new figure shows a gain of 515 students in daytime classes and 1,580 students during the evening hours.

With record enrollments in surrounding high schools and junior high schools, Harbor Junior College according to the experts, may look forward to increased enrollments each semester through 1963 when a leveling off period is predicted.
