

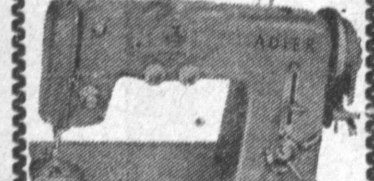

'Substance' Sermon Title

In the lesson-sermon on "Substance" planned for the First Church of Christ, Scientist, 1750 Manuel ave., Sunday, March 11, Mary Baker Eddy declares in "Science and Health with Key to the Scriptures," "The prayer that reforms the sinner and heals the sick is an absolute faith that all things are possible to God, a spiritual understanding of Him, an unselfed love" (page 1).

Torrance Ministers Join in Sponsoring Film on Christ

Officers of the Torrance Ministerial association are cooperating with the Church Federation of Los Angeles and the Southern California council of Protestant churches to bring "Day of Triumph" to 10 greater Los Angeles theaters starting Friday, March 16, Dr. Forrest C. Weir, executive director of the federation-council, declared this week.

Residents of Torrance who buy tickets can attend any one of the 10 theaters but the Park, Huntington Park and Fifth Avenue, Inglewood, are the closest. It also will be at the La Mar, Manhattan Beach.

Those sharing in the activity are the Reverend F. A. Brunson, president, and the Reverend H. Milton Sippel, secretary of the Torrance group.

Several churches here are selling tickets and proceeds will go toward worthy Christian projects, Dr. Weir said.

"Day of Triumph," the Lenten picture in color and on wide screen, is the first production depicting the life of the Saviour since "The King of Kings" 30 years ago.

It runs for nearly two hours and is expected to bring a message of hope to all who view it, according to Dr. Weir.

Adventists Set Offering for Famine Relief

A special offering for disaster and famine relief will be taken at the Seventh-day Adventist church Saturday, March 10, according to Glenn L. Goffar, pastor.

This is the first nationwide offering for this purpose to be taken in Adventist churches in six years, the pastor stated. It will restore denominational funds set aside for this purpose which have shrunk rapidly in the past two years.

Heavy demands arising from natural disasters here in North America as well as overseas have drained the budget.

In spite of the availability of surplus foodstuffs from the government for overseas relief, more than \$250,000 has been spent by the church in distribution of such aid as well as in providing other emergency relief, the pastor reported.

Also singing will be Mrs. Martin, who is now president of the Missionary societies of the Los Angeles area.
