All members and friends of the church are welcome to attend the 8 p.m. program in the

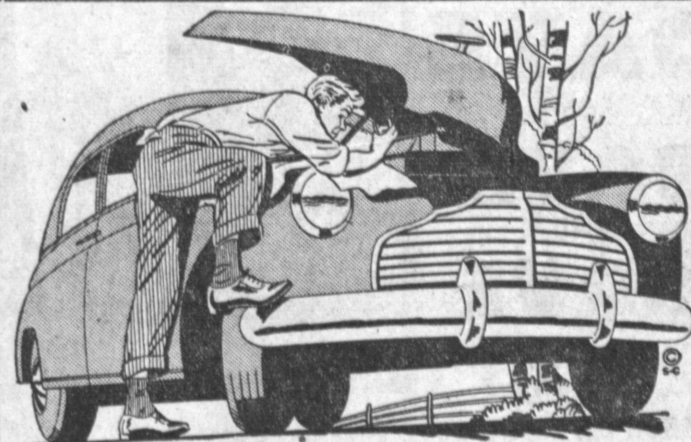
