

Sets 2-Year Youth Plans

Recommendations adopted recently by the 7th Conference on Childhood and Youth included parent-teacher conferences at all levels with attention to "pre-delinquent" behavior, and help for the "gifted and emotionally disturbed" child as well as the handicapped.

Other recommendations were for classroom discussions on mate selection, marital adjustment, and other facets of education for family life.

The 600 delegates from the Los Angeles area attending the concluding breakfast session at the Ambassador Hotel also voted approval of proposed legislation for better support of mental health programs; more school nurses and physicians; and adequate financial help for needy families who are now ineligible for public assistance.

George Hjelte, conference chairman, called for votes on each recommendation. They were offered by Los Angeles Municipal Court Judge Ben

County Plans Car Derby

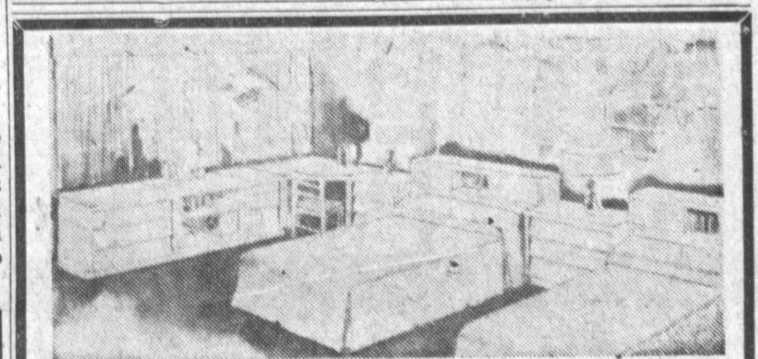
Applications for the Los Angeles County Hot Rod Indianapolis Derby are available at the Torrance Police station, Sheriff E. W. Biscailuz has announced.
