

Nite School Will Hold Open House

Student activities in the various adult classes will be displayed Friday, May 25, at the annual open house sponsored by the Torrance evening high school.

The Torrance Adult Education program has been designed to meet the needs of this community and students participating in its program are doing so for the purpose of getting high school diplomas, preparing for entrance into college, to obtain additional training for upgrading purposes, to improve their employment status and to provide for leisure time activities.

The latter areas include ceramics and mosaics, cake baking, and decorating, lampshade making, knitting, rug making, personality and appearance classes,

landscape gardening, business education, parent education and so forth.

Vocational needs are met through such classes as wood-working, machine shop, blueprint reading, dressmaking, tailoring, millinery.

Those pursuing high school diplomas and preparing for college are taking advantage of academic subjects such as English, Spanish, French, mathematics, typing, bookkeeping, business education, public speaking, civics and American history.

During the open house classes in woodworking and machine shop will be in operation. The cake baking and decorating class will have on display various types of cakes decorated for special occasions in Room 112, Science Building. All other classes projects will be displayed in the

Torrance high school cafeteria. From 7:30 to 9 p.m. the dress-making and tailoring classes, millinery and knitting classes will model garments made by students. The personality and appearance class will demonstrate what it takes to be well dressed for every occasion.

\$18 Million Distributed Among Douglas Employees

An all-time record of \$18,000,000 in annual vacation and sick leave paychecks—including \$5,200,000 to 20,300 hourly employees of the El Segundo division—were handed out Friday by Douglas Aircraft co.

T. E. Springer, division vice-president general manager, said the payment to his people was in addition to the El Segundo normal weekly payroll of \$2,438,000. This means Douglas workers in this area alone received a grand total of \$7,638,500 on one pay day.

The El Segundo division, largest of five operated by Douglas throughout the United States, embraces plants in El Segundo and Torrance.

Torrance Share Told
Springer said the banner disbursement of sick leave and vacation pay was divided as follows at the two locations:

El Segundo—\$3,339,459 among 12,682 hourly employees for a total weekly payroll of \$4,952,982; Torrance—\$1,849,177 among 7600 hourly employees for a total payroll of \$2,662,992. Douglas distributes its annual sick leave and vacation pay

in a lump sum to some 65,000 hourly employees at the start of each year's vacation period irrespective of whether they have taken time off during the preceding year, Springer said.

Checks Averaged \$353
The average hourly employee took home from one to four weeks additional pay yesterday, depending on his individual length of service. In the El Segundo division, Springer disclosed, the average hourly worker's gross paycheck totaled \$353.39.

The vice-president also reported that the company's total combined hourly and salary payrolls this week exceeded any in the company's 36-year history, including World War II years of considerably higher numerical employment.

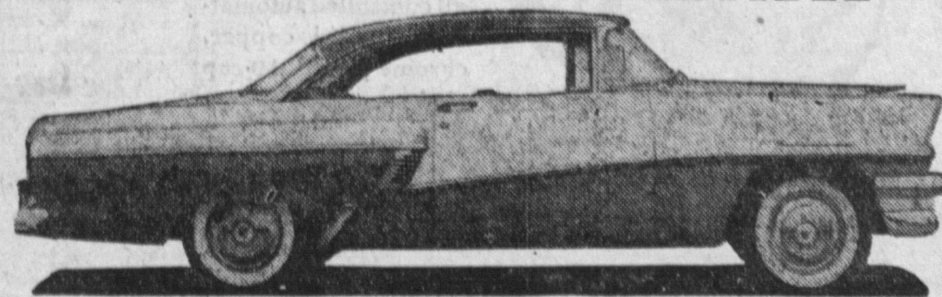

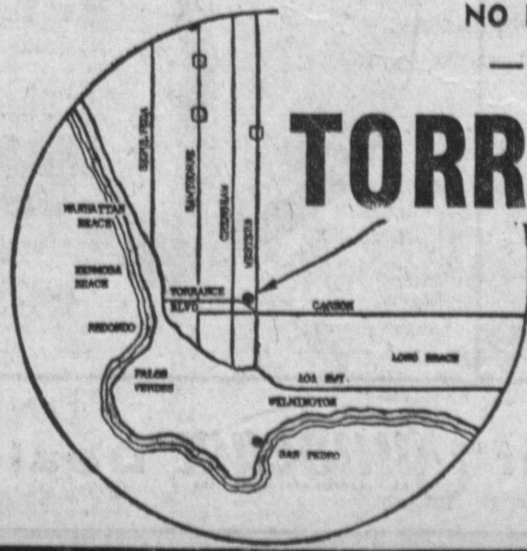
