**Leon Varkas To Teach In San Pedro**

Leon Varkas, formerly first soloist of Ballet Theatre, and Mordkin Ballet, New York, will begin a thirteen week engagement, June 18, as guest teacher at the Rosalie & Alva Dance Studio, 1417 W. 8th Street, San Pedro.

The famous dancer will teach while Rosalie and Alva are in Europe on a combination vacation and dance tour.

Varkas will conduct classes in classical ballet, moderne character and women's body conditioning.

Leon Varkas received most of his dance training in Paris under Prima Ballerinas, Preobrajenska and Vera Trefilova.

A native of the United States, Varkas danced throughout Europe before returning to this country where he appeared as soloist with Mordkin Ballet, Ballet Theatre and the Metropolitan Opera Ballet.

Rosalie and Alva Lincir will leave Sunday, June 10. They will board the Ile de France on June 12.

Their itinerary includes France, Zurich, Switzerland, and Yugoslavia.

Lincir left Yugoslavia at the age of 10, and will be returning to his home for the first time.

Rosalie and Alva have played engagements at supper clubs and concert halls throughout both North and South America.

Mrs. Lincir is well-known for having set a world's record for pirouettes.

They have an 11-year-old son, Tommy Ivanko Lincir, named after Lincir's uncle who was a Yugoslavian war hero.

During the course of their tour, they plan to visit Miss Patti Chater, one of their students who was recently accepted as a member of the Sadler's Wells Ballet Troupe.

**Bloodmobile Coming Here**

"Blood plus dollars equal life-saving prescriptions!"

Such was the assertion of Mrs. Virginia Jones today as she announced that the Red Cross bloodmobile will be at the Civic Auditorium on Monday, June 11, from 3 p.m. until 7:30 p.m. for the benefit of all local blood donors.

Mrs. Jones, Torrance's blood program chairman, indicated that residents play a "twin role" when they participate in the Red Cross blood program.

"You are the 'twin' who contributes the blood," she explained, "and you are the 'twin' who paid for the cost of collecting and processing that blood when you contributed to the annual fund campaign.

"Thus, together," she said, "you make it possible to transfuse blood into the veins of some patient making the fight for life."

Urging donors to make appointments for next month's bloodmobile visit by calling her at DA. 6-1617, the chairman went on to explain that whole blood or a blood derivative is prescribed for thousands of hospitalized patients each month.

"Should the patient be you or a member of your immediate family," she stressed, "Red Cross will fill the prescription.

"This Red Cross service will continue as long as you and the organization to which you belong support the program with blood and dollars."
