The dance starts at 8:30. Doors will open at 7:30, for all who wish to take advantage of the free dance instruction which will be given one hour prior to the dance.


Local Park Schedule Told

The following schools will reopen July 2, for supervised recreation programs. Carr, Carl Steele, Crenshaw, Hillside, Greenwood, Madrona, North




