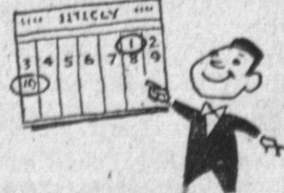

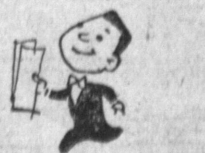

ALONDRA PICNIC SHELTER

Supervisor Kenneth Hahn announced this week that the board of supervisors had voted to award contract for the construction of a new picnic shelter, bridge and area lighting at Alondra park to the Hane Construction company.

The picnic shelter is to be constructed in the southeast section of the park and will cover an area approximately 120 feet long and 30 feet wide. The structure will have a wing-type roof and will contain 18 permanent picnic tables, 10 double gas stoves and 10 sinks. Outside the picnic shelter there will be a graveled area for additional picnic tables, Supervisor Hahn said.

The bridge will extend from the east side of the lake to the island and will be approximately 12 feet wide and 50 feet long. It will be constructed of concrete block supports, wood platform and railing.

Future plans for the island at Alondra park include a small Treasure Island in the middle of the lake for children.

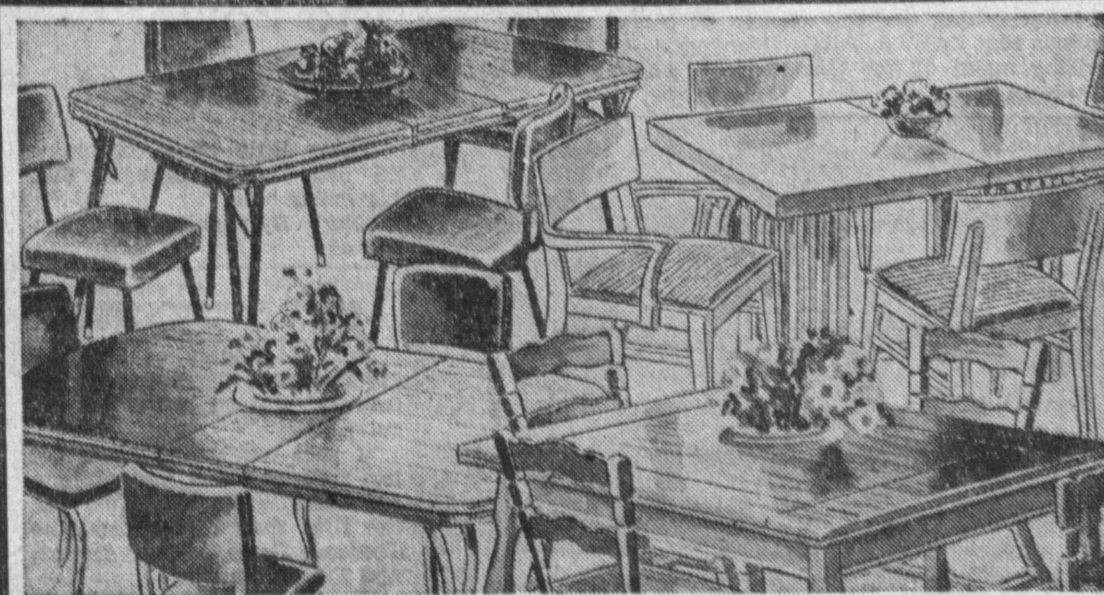
