

are a child of God, an heir with Jesus Christ. "There is no condemnation to them that are in Christ Jesus." You are born again by His Holy Spirit and kept by His power. Christ will come again and receive you unto Himself and give you a home in Heaven. This is life eternal to know Him and trust in His precious blood, which is symbolized by the grape juice we drink together at the Lord's Supper. This is the richest experience on earth to remember His death until He comes. Truly we love Him because He first loved us.

The crown of thorns in our text this week reveals God's remedy for the curse of sin. Behold, the Lamb of God as He stands before Pilate. He was rejected, despised, spit upon, buffeted and crucified between two thieves. The curse of

plan of salvation is very plain. "Believe in the Lord Jesus Christ and thou shalt be saved." This wonderful love of God is manifested in a full and free forgiveness of all our sins. Not only are we forgiven but God gives us Christ's righteousness which means justification, or counted righteous before God on the ground that another, even His Son, Jesus Christ, took our gilt and bore in His own body the punishment due us. He alone was sinless and His blood alone could cleanse us from sin. This truth from God's Holy Word is the best news that ever occupied the thought of man. To accept this Gospel gives assurance and peace, and you can be sure of God's gift of eternal life. Do you have that certainty from the Word of God? Read First John 5:13. When you have Jesus Christ as your personal Saviour, you

Yes, man in his mockery placed on Him a crown of thorns and a scarlet robe. They also placed a reed in His hand and then bowed the knee before Him. Little did they realize that He had stepped down from Heaven's royal throne, out from the Ivory Palaces to come into the world of sin and shame. He died for you. He died for me. The King of Kings was crucified. He is now at the Right Hand of God. He was raised from the dead and is coming again. He would be your Saviour and your High Priest King. Receive Him today.
