### Miss Dawn's Swim School Offers Expert Instruction

Under the expert direction of Walter Crowe, Miss Dawn's Swim School, 215 Ave. "I", in Redondo Beach, is entering its third year of swimming instruction in this area.

A specially constructed outdoor heated pool, 50x40 in size, is used by the seven expertly trained swimming instructors, equipped to handle between 250 to 300 students in each of the four week sessions.

**Limit Classes**  
The classes, which are limited to five students at a time, are given in 12 sessions, 45 minutes each. The school is open from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., six days a week, so that everyone can be accommodated. As a special feature, all students are taken to the beach to learn about surf safety, and to become familiar with ocean swimming.

Swimming is taught at all levels, beginning with youngsters four years of age, and including experienced swimmers who wish to improve their technique. Adult lessons are also given two evenings a week.

**Swim Meet**  
At the end of each four week session, all students are involved in a water demonstration for the benefit of their parents and friends. In line with this policy, a swimming meet will be held on Sunday, July 15, one demonstration at 11 a.m. and one at 2:30 p.m. to which the public is also invited.

Walter Crowe, director of the swim school, is a graduate of UCLA, class of '41; received his Master of Science degree at UCLA in 1951; and is working on his Doctorate in Physical Education at USC. At the present time, he is supervisor of student teaching in Physical Education at Long Beach State College, where he has taught for the past four years.
