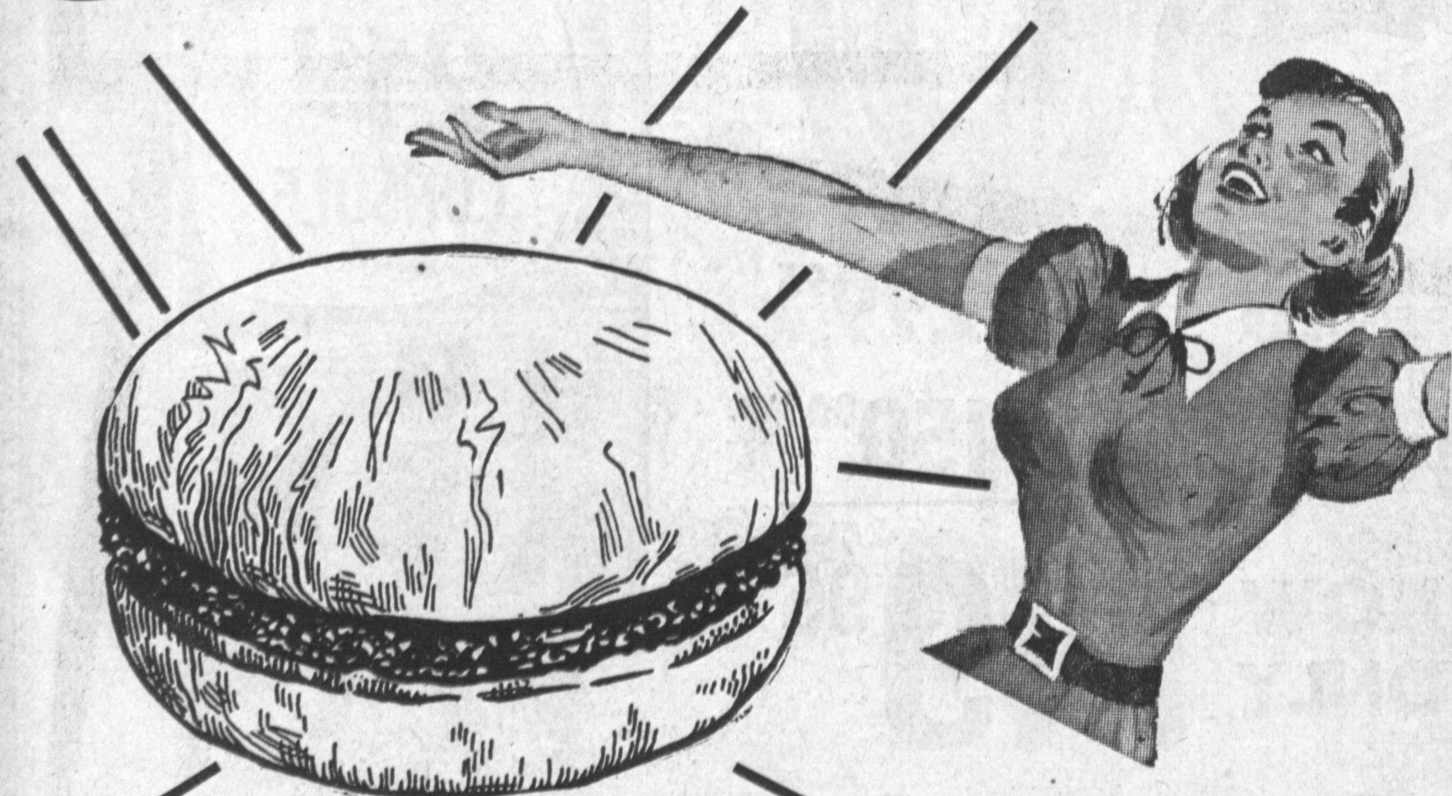

#### Oppose Incorporation

The already large, and steadily growing, Citizens Committee Opposing the Incorporation of Lomita feels apologetic toward the representatives of the hills communities who came as invited guests to a meeting at California Hall, and were, in effect, accused of bad faith and threatened with coercion when they declined incorporation with Lomita. The affront was based upon the pretext that the hill area had not been polled. We believe that had their answer as to incorporation been affirmative, the question of a poll

would not have arisen, nor would their authority as delegates have been challenged.

The Citizens Committee Opposing the Incorporation of Lomita submits that Lomita has not been polled. Even the full membership of the Chamber of Commerce has not been polled. The discourtesy to the hill area delegates did not come from the people of Lomita. The Chamber of Commerce includes only one per cent of our population. Our Committee challenges any claim of a small segment of the Chamber of Commerce that they represent all of Lomita.

The Citizens Committee Opposing the Incorporation of Lomita offers an apology to the representatives of the hill communities, because we feel that the treatment they received here was below the standard we desire for Lomita.

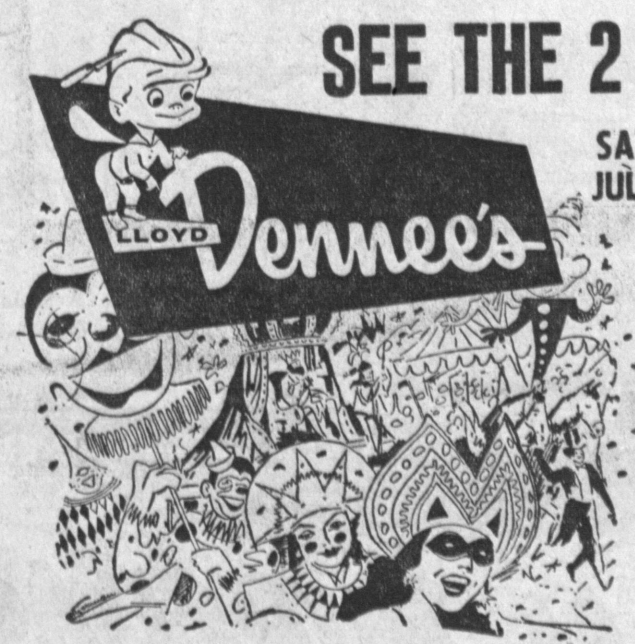
