Carson Area Gets County Health Clinic

Formal approval of a fiveyear lease for quarters for a County Child Health Clinic to serve the Carson-Dominguez Area and the surrounding area was given Tuesday by Supervisor Burton W. Chace.

The Clinic to be located at 402 E. 231st Street will be operated by the County Health department, under the direction of Dr. Roy O. Gilbert. Chace announced that the clinic will be opened as soon as the necessary remodelling work is fin-

Gilbert stated that initial plans call for the clinic to be opened one day each week to provide pre-natal and post-natal care. Ultimately the program will be expanded to include the services of a public health nurse, a district health officer, and a communicable disease clinic, Chace declared.
