Immediate action was promised this week to remedy shameful conditions on 182nd st., west of Crenshaw blvd. following complaints by nearby homeowners regarding unsightly and unhealthy shacks. This assurance was given this week by Tom Sibley, right-of-way agent

for the California Division of Highways. The matter involves State-owned homes which are being rented tempo-

rarily or standing vacant until they can be removed for the freeway that is scheduled to go through there.

Sibley said that the State has investigated the situation and found it every bit as bad as complaining homeowners have stated.

He said that his office would get the homes fixed up and put back in good condition; kick out tenants who have failed to take care of the property; rerent the homes but raise the restrictions in order to get the right kind of tenants; and stake out the area to catch vandals.

"Parents of youngsters caught vandalizing the houses should know that they are liable up to \$300," Sibley said, adding that the State would prosecute to the limit.

He said the freeway would probably go through in about two years. "This is my personal guess," he added.
