5:35 p.m., ten minutes after the accident happened.

Rescue
Jim Enright and Johnny Kunkle made the steep descent, placing Hammond in a wire basket stretcher and administering First Aid.

Hammond was unconscious at the time, according to life guards.

The lifeguard rescue boat, Bay Watch, came in to assist, and lifeguards carried Hammond down to the boat which took him to the Redondo Beach pier where the South Bay ambulance was waiting to whisk him away to Harbor General hospital. Palos Verdes police helped in the rescue operation.

Hammond reportedly regained consciousness while on the boat, managing to understand what lifeguards had to say. He, himself, did not say anything.

He reportedly arrived at the hospital by 6:45 p.m. and died shortly after, at 7:30 p.m.

War Hero
Hammond, according to members of the family, was a sergeant with the 101st Airborne Paratroopers, the only one with rank to land behind enemy lines in the Battle of Bastogne, other officers having been killed by enemy fire.

Hammond, and about 30 men who managed to land, were caught in a trap but held out three days until help arrived.

He was the recipient of a number of military citations, including the Distinguished Service Cross and two Purple Hearts.

Hammond came to Torrance about one month ago from Portland, Oregon. He, his wife, Lorraine, and a 7-months old baby boy, were living with his mother, Florence M. Hammond, at the Garnet street address. Hammond had gone to work
