

LA Meets Teacher Shortage

Unlike the majority of school systems throughout the country, the Los Angeles City Schools will not be faced with a teacher shortage when the new school year begins September 17, according to Superintendent of Schools Claude L. Reeves. "All classes scheduled for the opening day of school will be covered by assigned teachers," Reeves stated in announcing that the city school's personnel division has just concluded an intensified drive to hire regular and substitute teachers for the fall semester. The successful recruitment of enough teachers to staff the city's classrooms this fall was conducted in the face of stiffest competition prevailing for available teacher candidates. "Virtually all of our vacancies will be filled by regular credentialed teachers who fully meet our system's strict stan-

However, slightly more than five per cent of the total need will be filled with carefully screened provisional teachers who possess a bachelor's degree and teacher training, but do not have a regular credential. Many of these teachers, especially in the junior and senior high school district, come from out-of-state and are highly qualified in every respect but do not meet California's requirements for a secondary school credential.

Harbor Tech Offers 121 Evening Courses

One hundred twenty-one separate courses, including classes in each of the seven divisions of the college, will be offered in the extended day program at Harbor Junior college during the fall semester, Raymond J. Casey, director of the college, announced today. Some of the courses being offered in each division are as follows: APPLIED TECHNOLOGY DIVISION: Engine shop, diesel fuel injection systems, instrument shop, introduction to shop practices, bench and drill press work, machine tool operation, milling machine and planer work, machine shop practices, advanced machine shop, machinist tool and die (technical re-

lated information), refining processes, petroleum processing, refining processing design, offset platemaking and camera work, print shop, bookbinding, linotype mechanism, radio shop, television shop, and electronics laboratory.

BUSINESS EDUCATION DIVISION: Accounting principles, intermediate accounting, income tax procedures, business mathematics, business law, introduction to business, human relations in business, salesmanship, small business management, freight traffic management, elements of supervision, management and labor, safety training and fire prevention, human relations, calculating machines, machine bookkeeping, rotary and business English.

CONSTRUCTION AND ART DIVISION: Home planning, home decorating and furnishing, architectural problems, strength of materials, art structure, life drawing, sketching and painting, creative ceramics, tool design, mechanical drafting, refinery piping drafting, blueprint reading, descriptive geometry, engineering drafting, elementary algebra, intermediate algebra, plane geometry, college algebra, college trigonometry, plane analytical geometry, slide rule, general college mathematics, and marine and celestial navigation.

HUMANITIES DIVISION: English fundamentals, reading and composition I and II, speed reading, Latin American civilization, science and modern man, band, introduction to philosophy, and public speaking I.

NATURAL SCIENCE DIVISION: Cookery for the home, general chemistry I, introductory physics, and photography.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION DIVISION: Drill-peg team, and personal and community hygiene.

SOCIAL SCIENCE DIVISION: Fire administration courses, introduction to western civilization, political and social history of the United States, vehicle code, evidence, police supervision, narcotics, criminology, general psychology and introduction to family living.

All Harbor Junior college night classes are tuition-free and open to any person 18 years of age or older. Persons interested in any of the courses may enroll during the registration period, September 17-18, during the hours from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. and from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m.
