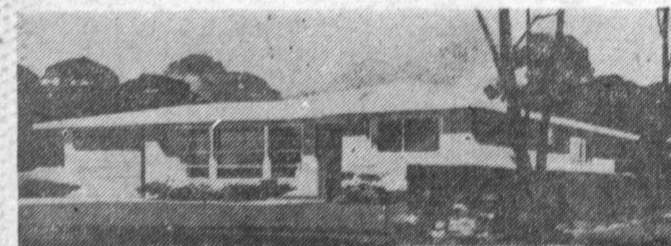

Size of Center

The center itself will be 650,000 square feet including the May co. store and will incorporate many of the latest architectural innovations. 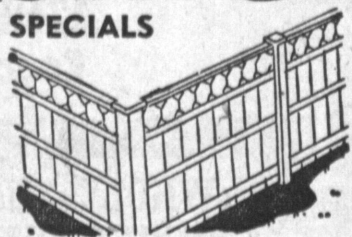

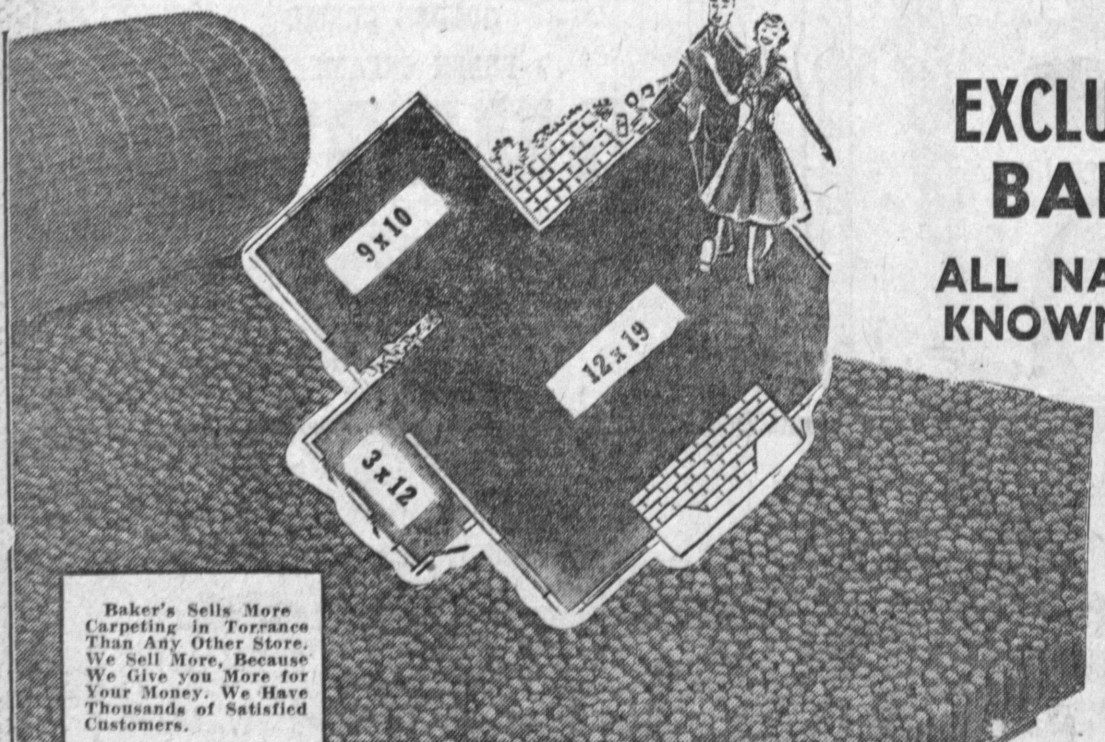

New Local Catholic Parish Told

The establishment of a new Catholic parish in this area was decreed recently by His Eminence, the Most Reverend Archbishop Aiden J. Bell, auxiliary bishop of Los Angeles.

Father Callahan recently served as administrator of Our Lady of Malibu church, Malibu. Father Callahan is a native of Worcester, Massachusetts, and an alumnus of Holy Cross college. He made his philosophy studies in Montreal and his theology at St. Mary's seminary, Baltimore.

He was ordained June 11, 1938, in Springfield, Massachusetts, for the Los Angeles Archdiocese. He was assistant pastor of St. Mary Magdalene parish before his recent temporary appointment to Malibu.
